Sermon Questions

Read Acts 16:16-21

- Is there an area of obedience, compassion, or courage He is shaping in you before the “chains” ever arrive?

Read Acts 16:22-24

- When you feel trapped, mistreated, or pressed down, what rises to the surface: complaint, fear, or faith?

Read Acts 16:25

- What would it take for worship (not despair) to be your first response in suffering?

Read Acts 16:26-34

- How could your testimony lead someone else to salvation?

Read Acts 16:35-40

- Where is God calling you to act, not for yourself, but for the sake of others?

What chain in your life do you need to entrust to God today so He can fill that place with worship?
