

Adat Is Centered On the Biblical Calendar March 11, 2017 Rabbi Jacob Rosenberg



Calendar starts broad and becomes very specific (299 times "month" in OT)


- 1. Biblical Calendar is a part of Creation
 - 1. Sun, Moon, And Stars (Gen. 1:14, Eccl. 3:1, Matthew 24, Rev. 12)
 - 2. Days of the Week as numbers
 - 3. 7 Weeks, 7 Cycles
 - 4. This can be seen in the Hebrew language itself. Some of the sages note that the Hebrew word for "year" shanah (שָׁנָה) shares the same root as both the word "repeat" (שְׁנָה) and the word "change" (שְׁנָה)
 - 5. 5777 comes from the adding of ages of the characters in OT
 - 6. The First month (Exodus 12:1-14) Av
 - 7. The Sabbath (Exodus 16, 20)
- 2. The Biblical Calendar is centered on God's Appointed Times (Lev. 23:1-3)
 - 1. Shabbat
 - 2. Passover
 - 3. Unleavened Bread
 - 4. First Fruits
 - 5. Festival of Weeks (Shavout)
 - 6. Festival of Trumpets (7th month)
 - 7. Day of Atonement
 - 8. Tabernacles
 - 9. Other Jewish Holidays
 - 1. Purim
 - 2. Hanukkah

3. The Biblical Calendar is God's not ours (Not Jewish Holidays)

- 1. Isaiah 1:1-20 (Amos 5)
- 4. The Biblical calendar is fulfilled in Yeshua
 - 1. Sabbath (NT)
 - 2. Passover/Unleavened Bread (NT)
 - 3. First Fruits (Resurrection)
 - 4. Acts 2 (Shavout)
 - 5. (1 Cor. 15:51-52; 1 Thess. 4:16-17 Rev. 8-9). (Trumpet)
 - 6. Yom Kippur (Hebrews)
 - 7. John 7:37-39 (Sukkot)
 - 8. John 10:22-30 (Hannukah)
