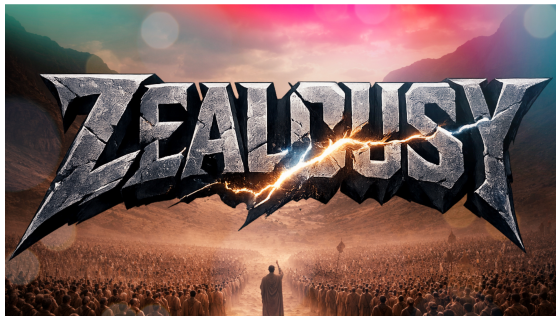

Read Joshua 24:1–2a

- Do I live with an awareness that I am standing before God?

- Where might my “yes” to God be quick but unexamined?

- What do I need to put away, and how can I turn my heart toward God?

Read Joshua 24:24

- Where do I need to move from saying to actually obeying?

Read Joshua 24:25–28

- What would it look like to live this out beyond this moment?
