Sermon Questions

Read John 11:1-16

How does calling death an “enemy” give us permission to grieve, weep, and even feel anger while still holding resurrection hope?

Read John 11:7-16

Can grief and gladness, anger and trust, sorrow and hope coexist? What does Yeshua show us about holding multiple emotions at once?

Read John 11:17-27

What disappointment with God have you been afraid to bring to Him because you thought it showed a lack of faith?

Read John 11:28-37

What emotions have you struggled to allow yourself to feel while still trusting God?

Read John 11:28-37

How does knowing God’s final answer to death is resurrection change how we grieve now?
