What does God's grief teach us about how to walk with Him when the world is broken?

Sermon Questions

Read Genesis 6:1-6

- When things break or disappoint me, do I tend to move first toward grief and honesty, or toward anger, avoidance, or control?
- When I see brokenness in the world or in my own life, do I allow myself to grieve what has been lost, or do I rush past the pain without naming it?

Read Genesis 6:7-8

- When grief shows me that something cannot continue as it is, do I respond with faithful change, or with resentment, bitterness, or withdrawal?

Read Genesis 6:9-12

- In this season of my life, am I trying to be perfect, or am I simply walking with God where I am?

Read Genesis 6:13-22

- Where might God be asking me to trust Him to build a way through my grief, rather than trying to fix it or escape it myself?
- Am I willing to keep walking with God in my grief, even if I do not yet see the way forward?
