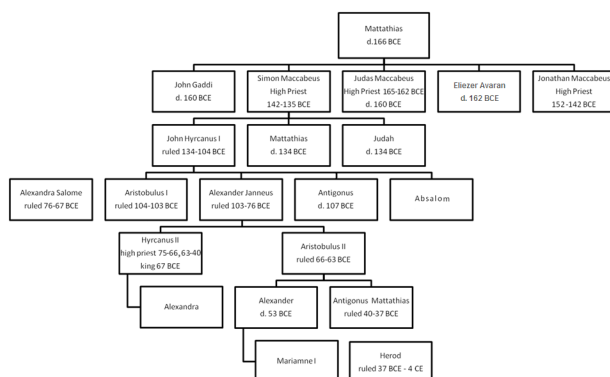

Background: Hanukkah is not mentioned in scripture as the festival of lights. It is referred to as the feast of dedication in the non-conical book of 1 Maccabees and in the John 10:24. But what is dedication all about, why do we do it, and how will the Messiah change things?

- Read John 10:22-30 Yeshua and Feast of Dedication
 - Who is Yeshua saying he is?
- Matthew 24:1-31
 - List out some of the signs of the Messiahs return
 - 1-8 Birth-pangs?
 - 9-14 What is the sign the end will come?
 - 15-28 What is the difference between tribulation and the great tribulation.
 - 29-31 What will messiahs return be like?
