How can we live in repentance, humility, and obedience, trusting God's approval instead of material results?

Sermon Questions

Read Matthew 3:1-6 (Repentance)

- What needs to change in your heart so you can make room for God's work?
- How can turning from sin in our lives prepare the way for God to act in and through us?

Read Matthew 3:7-10; John 15:1-8; Gal 5:22-23 (Fruitfulness)

- What does the "fruit" of faith look like in your daily life?
- How can we encourage each other to produce real change that honors God?

Read Matthew 3:11-12 (Humility)

- How can we point others to Yeshua instead of ourselves?
- Why is humility essential in living a life of faith?

Read Matthew 3:13-17 (Obedience and Trust)

- Which area of repentance, humility, or obedience do you feel God calling you to grow in this week?
- How would your life change if you rested in God's approval instead of proving it through material success?
