## JABEZ FAITH

Rabbi Jacob Rosenberg

**What kind of faith stands out in a world full of forgotten names?**

### Sermon Questions

Read 1 Chronicles 4:1-8, 11-43

- Sometimes it feels like we are just one name in a long list of forgotten people. Rebuilding our identity, religious life, and understanding of God's covenant can feel overwhelming in times of pain.

Read 1 Chron 4:9

- How can faith transform a painful beginning?

Read 1 Chron 4:10

- How does Jabez's prayer teach us about faith?
- What types of prayer do you see in this verse?
  - What does it say about your faith when you begin prayer with worship rather than just making requests?
  - What stopping you from trusting God's blessing even when it's not yet visible?
  - Where in your life (family, work, ministry) is God inviting you to pray for greater influence?
  - What area of pain is God asking you to trust His power and presence to lead to redemption?
  - Do you believe, like Jabez, that God can turn your legacy of pain around?

Try praying each one of these types of prayers as a group after sharing.

### Nation: Lebanon

- Pray for Lebanese to be drawn to the hope of Yeshua amid economic and political turmoil.
- Pray for the love of Yeshua to capture the hearts of Hezbollah members.
- Pray for Yeshua-centered renewal in the traditional and orthodox churches.
- Pray for this nation to have a heart for Israel.

### Israel and Hamas War

- All hostages are released.
- The military will act wisely in military operations.
- Pray for divine wisdom concerning Iran as we rely on God's sovereignty over the nations, and his prophetic plans for the nations will be accomplished.
