WHEN GOD REGRETS

Rabbi Jacob Rosenberg

What happens when we hear God's voice but choose to resist it instead of obeying it?

Sermon Questions

Read 1 Samuel 15:1-3

- What does this passage show about how clear God's command to Saul was?
- Where in your life is God's voice already clear right now?
- How can you tell the difference between needing guidance and needing obedience?

Read 1 Samuel 15:13-21

- How does Saul describe his actions, and how does that differ from reality?
- What are some ways people today redefine or adjust obedience?
- Where might you be tempted to call something "obedience" that is actually a compromise?

Read 1 Samuel 15:22-24, 35

- What does "to obey is better than sacrifice" mean in this context?
- What does Saul's confession ("I feared the people") reveal about the root of his resistance?
- The text says God "regretted." How does understanding this as relational (not a mistake) shape how you see obedience?

Nation: Uruguay

- Pray for spiritual hunger to replace Uruguay's deep secularism and materialism.
- Intercede amid high depression and suicide rates, asking God to restore a value for life.
- Ask for growth among believers and strength for churches in a post-Christian culture.
- Pray for leaders and for national transformation. Uruguay, which is often considered the most secular nation in South America.
- Pray this nation would support the restoration of Israel

Israel and Middle East

- Pray for those affected by the Israel-Iran conflict.
- Pray for wisdom for leaders and a path to peace.
- Pray for those facing trauma and loss.
- Pray against rising antisemitism.
- Pray for the peace of Jerusalem.
