Sermon Questions

Read Genesis 4:1-5

- When God's response challenges your expectations, which emotions tend to surface first: openness, defensiveness, resentment, or withdrawal?

Read Genesis 4:6-8

- What does it look like to do what is right in moments when strong emotion threatens to take control?
- What happens when sin is not mastered but allowed to rule?

Read Genesis 4:9-15

- What does this passage reveal about the difference between human anger and God's justice?

Read Genesis 4:16-26

- Where can increased ability or success make it easier to live without dependence on God?
- What does this section suggest about where realignment truly begins?
- What area of your life might require not more effort, but a cry to God for realignment?

- Pray for Kazakh Christians to seize opportunities to evangelize Central Asian immigrants.
- Pray that heads of families place their hope in Yeshua rather than in shamanistic practices.
