When do our good intentions get in the way of God's perfect plan, and how does faith help us yield instead of control?

Sermon Questions

Read John 18:1-11; John 10:17-18

- How does Yeshua's willingness show confidence in the Father's plan?

Read John 18:10-11; Proverbs 3:5-6

- Why does Peter draw his sword, and what does this reveal about his understanding of God's plan?
- How does this moment show that faith sometimes requires surrender instead of strength?

Read John 18:12-14; Acts 2:23

- How does knowing God's plan is at work even amid human schemes encourage your faith?
- What can this teach us about trusting God when circumstances seem out of control?

Read John 18:15-18; Exodus 14:13-14

- How does fear affect our faith in everyday life?

Read John 18:25-27; Luke 22:31-32

- What does this contrast teach us about faith that is impulsive versus faith that is tested?
- How can failure become a turning point for deeper trust in God?

Nation: Chad

- Pray for peacemaking leaders to govern with integrity over the diverse tribes.
- Pray for Muslims and animists to hear God's Word in their own languages.
- Pray for leaders to be raised up within the local churches who have a heart for outreach.
- Pray that the Nations would have a heart for Israel
