Sermon Questions

Read 2 Kings 6:1-7, Matt 6:26-30 (Small Things)

 Are there "small" areas of your life where you need to trust God's provision?

Read 2 Kings 6:8-17; Eph 6:12 (Unseen Things)

- What fears or challenges need God's perspective in your life?
- How can faith help you see God's work behind the scenes rather than focusing only on what you see?
