Read Luke 7:1-10 Sickness

Am I resting in what I have done for God, or trusting the authority of Yeshua's word?

Read Luke 7:11-17 Death

When I encounter someone's grief, do I see a tragedy to explain or a person to move toward?

Read Luke 7:18-35 Doubt & disorientation

When Yeshua does not act as I expected, will I bring my questions to Him and trust what His works reveal?

Read Luke 7:36-50 Sin & Shame

Have I become so focused on another person's past that I can no longer see the grace of God at work within them?

Will I allow the deep compassion of Yeshua to meet me in my helplessness, grief, uncertainty, and shame, and teach me to see others as He sees them?
