- How does one become justified? Is it really by works?

Read Romans 2:17-20

- How does Paul define self-righteousness?

Read Romans 2:21-29; Duet 30:5-6; Lev 26:40-45

- What happens to the gospel if God is blasphemed by believers?
- What does it mean to be circumcised of the heart?
