Sermon Questions

Read Exodus 32:1-6

- When I feel anxious or threatened, does my response protect covenant faithfulness?

Read Exodus 32:7-14

- When anger rises in me, how can I let covenant loyalty and remembered promises shape my response before I act?

Read Exodus 32:15-20

- How can my anger reflect God's moral seriousness while still protecting the relationship He has entrusted to me?

Read Exodus 32:21-24

- When I am confronted, how can I practice truthful ownership so that anger becomes a path to restoration rather than a form of self-protection?

Read Exodus 32:25-29

- Where is God calling me to take covenant faithfulness seriously without letting zeal outrun love?

Read Exodus 32:30-32

- In moments of conflict, how can I choose covenant loyalty over self-preservation?

Read Exodus 32:33-35

- How can I trust God's justice and lovingkindness enough to let my anger be tempered by mercy?
