**What does God do when judgment is near, but His people return to Him?**

### Sermon Questions

**Read Joel 2:1–11**

Am I responding to God's warning with repentance or delay?

**Read Joel 2:12–13**

Where is God saying to me, "Yet even now, return to Me"?

**Read Joel 2:14–17**

Am I appealing to God's mercy with surrender, or trying to control the outcome?

**Read Joel 2:18–22**

Do I believe God's compassion can interrupt judgment and quiet fear?

**Read Joel 2:23-27**

Do I believe God's mercy can turn shame into rejoicing?

**Read Joel 2:28–32**

Do I believe God's Spirit is meant to renew the whole community, including me?

If God's mercy can interrupt judgment, can I trust Him to meet my repentance with compassion rather than shame?
