John 1:35-42**

**I. It Requires An Introduction.** (vs. 35-38)

John the Baptist was good at his job.

When Jesus passed by John the Baptist and Andrew, John said, “Look, the Lamb of God!”

What Andrew found out you can know today. Jesus is the Christ. The Jewish Messiah. The Son of the Living God.

**II. It Continues With A Lasting Relationship.** (vs. 39)

“Staying” is one of the favorite words of the author of the gospel of John. He uses it 66 times. 40 times in this gospel.

True followers of Jesus want to stay with Him. They want to spend time with Him.
