The Celebration Choir, joined by community friends, will present Vivaldi's Gloria on the second Sunday of Advent, accompanied by a string ensemble with trumpet, oboe, and bassoon.

Vivaldi's joyful work celebrates the angels' proclamation from Luke: "Glory to God in the highest..." Originally written for the orphaned girl's chorus of the Ospedale della Pietà in Venice, the twelve-movement piece features SATB choir and several soloists. Lost after Vivaldi's death and rediscovered in the 1920s, it has become a beloved Christmas classic.
