Vivaldi's *Gloria* is a beloved work for the Advent and Christmas season—truly fitting at any time of year. Antonio Vivaldi, a virtuoso violinist trained by his father, Giovanni Battista, who played at San Marco in Venice,

was ordained a priest at age 25. Soon after, he was appointed violin instructor at the Ospedale della Pietà, a renowned orphanage for girls.

During his years at la Pietà, Vivaldi composed the *Gloria*. Although it is was likely first performed entirely by female voices, it is scored for SATB chorus, offering flexibility for performances beyond the orphanage.

A remarkably prolific composer, Vivaldi wrote more than 500 concerti—including *The Four Seasons*—along with over 50 sacred choral works and more than 40 operas. After his death, his music fell into private hands and disappeared from public view.

In the late 1920s, the *Gloria* was rediscovered in Turin, Italy, and received its first modern performance in Siena in 1939. Once published, its popularity quickly grew. Today, it is often associated with Christmas because its opening text echoes the angels' proclamation. It is sung regularly during the Catholic Mass:

"Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father."

Interestingly, the *Gloria* is not sung by the Catholic Church during Advent and Lent. However, Presbyterians joyfully sing "Glory to God" year-round!

May this music inspire you to worship with renewed devotion, to offer thanks to God, and to enter the Christmas season with gratitude and joy.


