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Ash Wednesday begins the 40-day period of fasting and renewal the church calls Lent. It is inspired by Christ's 40 days of fasting in the wilderness (Matthew 4:2) at the beginning of his public ministry. The Sundays in Lent are not included in the 40 days and are considered "celebration breaks" during the long time of preparation for the monumental events of Good Friday and Easter.

In Scripture, ashes serve both as a symbol of mortality and as a sign of mourning and repentance. But neither sin nor death is the final word. Believers leave the service with this confidence and gratitude: Christ has conquered sin and death. Nothing can separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Lent begins like a bare branch in winter. Just as the bare branch has been stripped of its glory, so Jesus had to surrender his glory and die for the sins of all before his Easter victory over death. It is in the stripping that we discover the mission of his life and the truth about our own. His pattern of dying, and rising, is meant for us as well. Lent is the 40-day season of repentance when we seek to die to all that is not of Christ, so that we can rise again to the glory of all that is.
