TODAY’S SCRIPTURE TEXT

Psalm 33: (KJV) Rejoice in the LORD, O ye righteous: for praise is comely for the upright.

² Praise the LORD with harp: sing unto him with the psaltery and an instrument of ten strings.

³ Sing unto him a new song; play skilfully with a loud noise.

⁴ For the word of the LORD is right; and all his works are done in truth.

⁵ He loveth righteousness and judgment: the earth is full of the goodness of the LORD.

⁶ By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.

⁷ He gathereth the waters of the sea together as an heap: he layeth up the depth in storehouses.

⁸ Let all the earth fear the LORD: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him.

⁹ For he spake, and it was done; he commanded, and it stood fast.

¹⁰ The LORD bringeth the counsel of the heathen to nought: he maketh the devices of the people of none effect.

¹¹ The counsel of the LORD standeth for ever, the thoughts of his heart to all generations.

***WE GIVE PRAISE AND THANKS TO GOD BECAUSE IT'S THE
RIGHT THING TO DO!***

1. #1—"BECAUSE OF GOD'S PERSON!"

- God is trustworthy in God's person and God is trustworthy in and of God's Self!
 - When Moses was given his assignment—he asked God—“When they ask me who sent me what should I tell them?—And God said—“I AM THAT I AM!”
 - I am ever evolving in relationship to any need that you might ever have!
 - I am so much of who I am that by the time you figure out what it is that you need—I already am that!

2. #2—“*BECAUSE GOD IS PATIENT!*”

- The Hebrew word used to express this is the word hesed which points to God's covenant faithfulness!”

- Heseb is most commonly translated in the English Bible as mercy because God's mercy is God's loving us!
- It's an unshakable unbreakable love a love that cannot and will not be changed by the objects of that love!

3. #3—"***BECAUSE OF GOD'S POWER!***"

Psalm 33, Verse 6, Says That—"The Lord just spoke!"

- God doesn't have to go through changes to bless you or transform you all God has to do is speak!
- God's speaking is a doing and God's doing is a speaking and when God speaks it—it's already done whether you see it or not!

4. #4—“*BECAUSE OF GOD’S PLAN!*”

- God’s plan never fails and that’s a reason to praise God!
- As the people of God we live under the plans of almighty God;

Jeremiah 29:11, Says—“I know the plans that I have for you—they are plans not to prosper you—and not to harm you—to give you a future and a hope...”

CONCLUSION
