<sup>21</sup> Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be.

- All of us are born with a clinched fist—BUT—all of us die with an open hand.
- Jesus had a laser-like focus, in His teaching, on management of money and minutes!
- Jesus focused on money and minutes—because money and minutes matter!
- We make a living by what we get—BUT—we make a life by what we give!

#### **HOW CAN I PRACTICE GENEROSITY?**

#### 1. MAKE THE RIGHT CHOICES!

*MATTHEW 6:19-21*—<sup>19</sup> "Don't store up treasures here on earth, where moths eat them and rust destroys them, and where thieves break in and steal.

- Our text today offers to us two choices of where we can invest our energy, effort, and our lives!
- It's as you invest in either earth—or as you invest in eternity!

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>20</sup> Store your treasures in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal.

#### 2. MAINTAIN THE RIGHT PERSPECTIVE!

- THREE THEOLOGICIAL PERSPECTIVES OF GIVING AND GENEROSITY:
- POVERTY, PROSPERITY, AND PROPER THEOLGY!
- The only thing that nobody can ever take from you is what you give away!
- SO—Jesus encourages us "TO GIVE WHAT WE CANNOT KEEP—SO WE CAN GAIN WHAT WE CANNOT LOSE!"
- BECAUSE—Jesus says—"Our lives do not consist in the abundance of our possessions!"
- DON'T CONFUSE YOUR SELF-WORTH WITH YOUR NET WORTH!
- Your life is not things!

## 3. MODEL THE RIGHT BEHAVIOR!

**MATTHEW 6:21** Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be.

- Where we invest our money and our minutes defines our movement—AND—reveals our motives!
- Because you can give without loving—BUT—you cannot love without giving!
- AND—God is not trying to take something from you—God is trying to give something to you!
- Because the text says—"To whom much is given—much will be required!"
- BUT—as you give away what God has given you—GOD WILL ALWAYS SEE TO IT THAT YOU HAVE MORE THAN ENOUGH!

#### 4. AND—MAGNIFY THE RIGHT MASTER!
