Luke 1:26-35

NLT: The Birth of Jesus Foretold

²⁶ In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a village in Galilee, ²⁷ to a virgin named Mary. She was engaged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of King David. ²⁸ Gabriel appeared to her and said, "Greetings, favored woman! The Lord is with you!"

²⁹ Confused and disturbed, Mary tried to think what the angel could mean. ³⁰ "Don't be afraid, Mary," the angel told her, "for you have found favor with God! ³¹ You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you will name him Jesus. ³² He will be very great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his ancestor David. ³³ And he will reign over Israel forever; his Kingdom will never end!"


Series Background & Message Summary

The story of Christmas found in the Gospel is unexpected. For the people of God, God had been silent for 400 years. Many of them felt forgotten and yet, in the quiet, dark corner of a city, God remembered and came to them. But not how they expected. God came in the form of a baby, not a king, a president, a dictator, bully, or powerful leader. Instead—Emmanuel—a name that means—"God Is with us"—a brownskinned immigrant in Palestine came unexpectantly by many as the promised miracle who would deliver...

This miracle came to all including the minority, the immigrant, those deemed illegal, struggling, the poor, marginalized, the young, the old, and everyone in-between—literally those with nothing and no reason to believe, hope, hang on, or look forward to!

The Gospels capture each person's response when they encountered the presence of God who came through a brown-skinned, immigrant, in Palestine during a time where the innocent—including babies—were being summarily murdered and killed with no consequence.

The Gospels capture their emotions—and our emotions at Christmas. This Christmas we discover and rediscover not only the many emotions we feel at Christmas, but also that God—(Emmanuel—meaning "God is with us")—is with us in all those experiences. We're reminded that God shows up in unexpected places and in miraculous ways.



THE POWER OF AN UNEXPECTED MEETING

1. "CHRONOS—from which we get the word "CHRONOLOGY" is one type of time..."

Galatians, Chapter 4, Verse 4, Declares That—
"...In the fullness of time God sent forth his son..."

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2. "KAIROS" is another kind of time—God's divine timing when time is right for God to meet, move, and manifest."

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3. "Luke, Chapter 1, records an encounter and meeting between Mary, the Angelic Messenger, Gabriel, and the Holy Spirit."
