Daniel 1: KJV: ⁸ But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.

NLT: ⁸ But Daniel was determined not to defile himself by eating the food and wine given to them by the king. He asked the chief of staff for permission not to eat these unacceptable foods.

BACKGROUND OF TODAY'S MESSAGE

- Words that change reality—based on the simple belief that WORDS SHAPE THOUGHTS—THOUGHTS SHAPE ACTIONS—ACTIONS SHAPE BEHAVIOR—and—BEHAVIOR SHAPES OUR DESTINY!
- And today we wanna focus on the word—"NO!"
- No is not necessarily negative!
- It's not necessarily a negative word;
- There are sometimes that "no" is a positive word;
- No is an important word;
- No is a word that can change your life;
- No can be an action word;
- "No" is an important word!
- No is an action word!
- No can be a positive word that can change your life! ++++++

- AND—there are many times that we must—as people of faith—say no!
- We have to say no if what's being planned—what's being done—what's being thought about is not in God's will!
- No!—if it's not appropriate or I have to compromise my integrity—or discard my personal dignity!
- No!—if what's being proposed is unwise—absurd—meaningless—and unwarranted!
- No!—if something is silly, stupid, and useless!
- No!—if it contradicts my humanity—or is outside my specificity!
- No!—if it denies my ethnicity—or impairs my immortality!
- No!—if it is self-destructive—and self-defeating!
- No!—if it's inhumane—and inconsiderate of others!
- No!—if it has no spiritual anointing—no Scriptural reference—and no useful purpose to uplift people—glorify God—and exalt the name of Jesus!

- Daniel's Life Was On A Wonderful Trajectory—BUT Things Did Not Turn Out As Planned!
- The people of God ran into trouble!
- All they had was a promise from God!
- And the truth about life—and the truth about the life of faith is that sometimes all you have is a promise from God!
- You don't have a trace of evidence—but just a promise—that says that no weapon formed against you can prosper!
- Just a promise that says—"He that hath begun a good work in you will perform in until the day of Jesus Christ—and He will!"
- Just a promise that encourages—"Be not weary in well-doing for you'll reap—in due season—IF—you faint not!
- Just a promise that says—"They that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength—they shall mount up on wings like eagles—they shall run and not be weary—walk and not faint!
