# Playing God | James 4: 11-17 | Discussion Questions

#### MONDAY - The Arrogance of Judging Others (James 4:11-12)

- ⇒ James puts 'judging others' in the context of slandering people (v11). How have you judged others with your words to put them down? How have you judged others in your heart or thoughts?
- ⇒ How can we encourage each other to leave the ways of the world and follow the way of Christ without judging and condemning each other?

### WEDNESDAY - Arrogant Planning (James 4:13-15)

- ⇒ How does the person described in verse 13 exhibit pride or arrogance? How have you made short-term or long-term plans in a similar way (in your career, finances, family, school, etc.)?
- $\Rightarrow$  What would it look like for you practically to surrender those plans to the Lord (v15)?

#### FRIDAY - Sins of Omission (James 4:16-17)

- ⇒ James covers two forms of arrogance, judging others and making plans without acknowledging the Lord. How is it evil to 'boast in your arrogance' (v16) in those areas?
- $\Rightarrow$  What causes us to know the right thing but fail to do it (v17)? Why is that sin?
