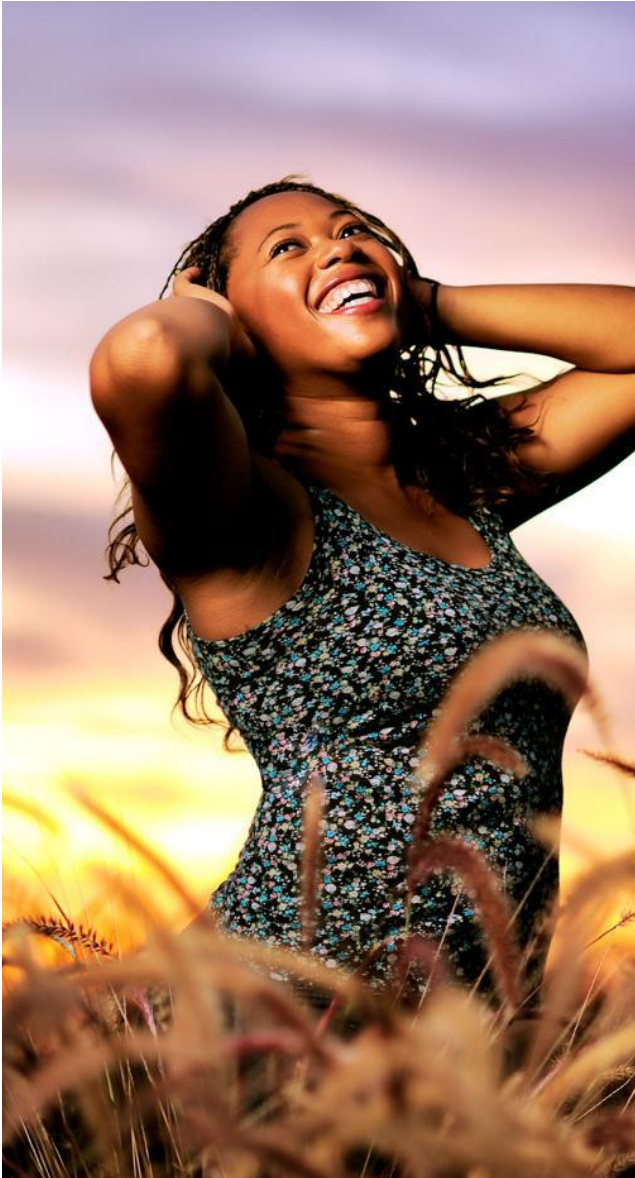

Surrender means trusting God with our lives now and our future ahead.



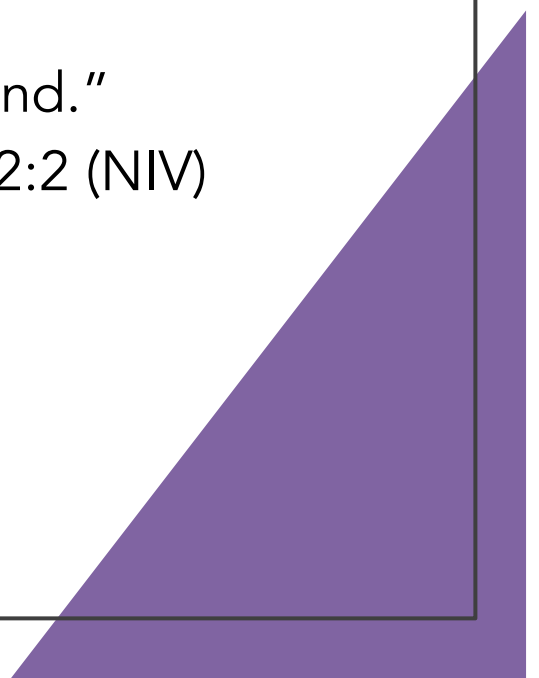
