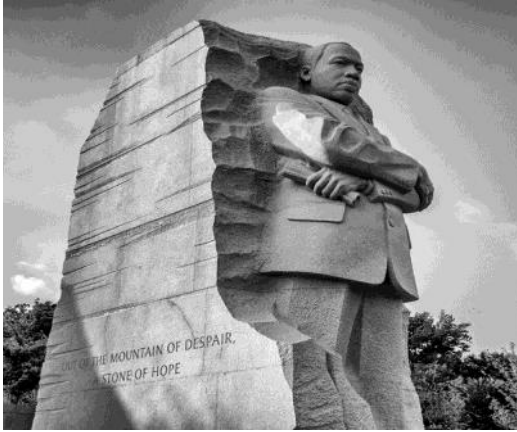

MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. DAY

Martin Luther King, Jr.

January 15, 1929 – April 4, 1968



Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was a man of God, a Baptist preacher in the right place at the right time. His wife Coretta King said, “Montgomery was the soil in which the seed of a new theory of social action took root,” that of non-violent protest in demanding social justice.

Dr. King’s fame began when Rosa Parks, tired from a day’s

work, sat down on a Montgomery bus in the first row behind the section reserved for whites, refused to stand for a white man boarding the bus, and was arrested. The black boycott of the buses was successful after one year with the Supreme Court’s affirmation that Alabama’s bus segregation laws were unconstitutional. The Montgomery buses were peacefully integrated with Dr. King’s leadership.

Dr. King was a hero, and black people finally had a weapon to fight the degradation, brutality, and murderous inhumanity of the segregated South non-violently and decently. Martin Luther King, Jr. used Mahatma Ghandi’s concepts of non-violent resistance plus love to bring about long-needed social reform. In Dr. King’s acceptance of the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964 he said, “I feel as though this prize has been given to me for something that has not yet been achieved. It is a commission to go out and work even harder for the things in which we believe.” Since Martin Luther King, Jr. gave up his life, a martyr for his people, we can continue the non-violent, Christ-like, loving resistance that he began against poverty, racism, and war. January 21st is a national holiday in honor of Dr. King. It is the only national holiday designated as a day of service. Dr. King said that anybody can serve. All that is required to continue his legacy is heart, soul, and love.

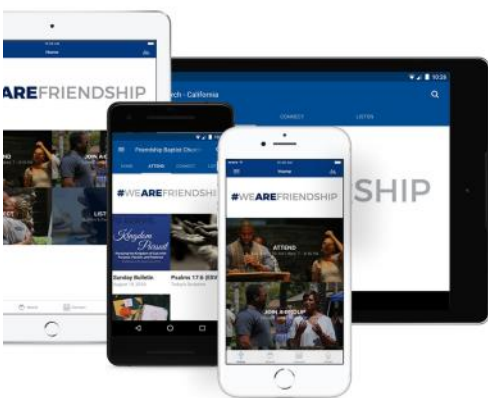
