- * Assists with the marketing needs of all Outreach Ministries to include but not limited to coordinating the bulletin announcements and working with the Media team.

- * Must work well with all volunteers and FBC staff.
- * Strong attention to detail and accuracy, including excellence in oral communications to verbalize issues clearly, concisely, and competently in positive or negative situation.

- * Must possess strong computer skills, including proficiency with spreadsheets, database, and Windows base software (Excel, Word, PowerPoint, Publisher)

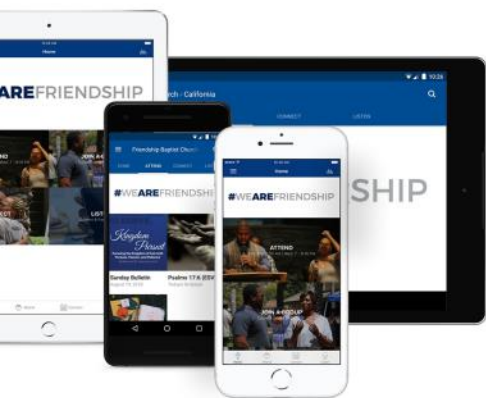
