Greetings Friendship Family,

Test the Tithe... It's a Mindset!

“Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and try Me now in this,” says the Lord of hosts, “if I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it.”  
-Malachi 3:10

In this passage of Scripture, God actually invites people to try (prove) Him—to verify His trustworthiness with their giving. He has given us a “fool-proof” test of His faithfulness! But it first requires a step of faith on our part.

He says that by disobeying Him in the tithe, we rob Him of the privilege of pouring out great and overflowing blessings. He calls for renewed giving with these promises.

First, there will be “food” or resources for God’s work (“in My house”).

Second, He says those who give will be placed in a position to receive great, overflowing blessings. Our obedience releases His faithfulness! You will experience the windows of heaven actually opening with blessings you will not be able to receive or contain!

Third, God says that He will “rebuke the devourer” for your sakes. He will cause every blessing that has your name written on it to be directed to you, and Satan himself cannot stop it.

Do not be afraid to try God with your giving. He is God and He will stand the test every time.

Test the Tithe (also known as Bring the Whole Tithe) is not another event, but a mindset and we want to continue to be faithful in returning our tithe throughout the year. We Test the Tithe as a Stewardship reminder to each of us so that we remember tithing is an expectation for believers and that tithing is all about FAITH! Remember, tithing (giving 10% of your income) on a regular basis not only supports the work we do at Friendship; it doesn't just support local missions and community growth, but it also demonstrates our obedience to God by making His Word and works a financial priority in our lives.

# CELEBRATE RECOVERY TESTIMONY

It's been said, "You can pick your friends, but you can't pick your family." Sadly, many of us find ourselves questioning God about why He gave us the family He did. Some of us have dealt with dysfunction that has greatly affected our lives. Many of us have suffered abuse or neglect at the hands of parents who were supposed to love us and give us childhoods that were safe and good. Is there hope for those of us who feel like the dysfunction we have endured can never be healed? Can God really work for the good in my family's relationships? My story answers a resounding "Yes" to these questions. The healing God worked in my family relationships began the day I stepped into my first Celebrate Recovery group 15 years ago.

I was about 38 years old and, though I was never technically diagnosed by a doctor, I was experiencing a nervous breakdown. I was depressed. I cried at the drop of a pin. Trying to focus on raising my kids was a huge challenge and life was difficult. Thankfully, I was a Christian and I knew from where my help came from. It always comes from the Lord. Through a series of events, I was sitting in a church service where they were showcasing testimonies from people within Celebrate Recovery. On this particular day, a man who was about 20 years older than I began to share his story that eerily mirrored my own upbringing. This man began to share how he grew up in a family in which he wanted for nothing. In fact, you could say he was spoiled. But there was something lacking. Something big. Something that many of us brush off as unimportant. The "something" was connection.

You see, this man's family, like my own, was dominated by a mother who was often angry and temperamental. His father was quiet, passive and a workaholic. This combination often produces a home where dysfunction flourishes and connection is almost non-existent. This man and I shared the same survival skills of learning how to "walk on egg shells." This means that we became very adept at making sure we didn't do anything to upset our moms. But of course, this is impossible. No one is perfect. But becoming perfect became our common goal. This gentleman told more of his story and finished it by telling about the healing he had begun to find in Celebrate Recovery. He told the audience that God had begun to change him and as a result, changes began to take place in his family.

After listening to this man's story, I knew that I had to attend the very next meeting for Celebrate Recovery. I wasn't sure which group I wanted to go to at the time, but I chose the group that focused on the issue of co-dependency. What is co-dependency? My simple definition is this: Co-Dependency is when you spend almost all your efforts to please someone or a group of people so that you can gain the love and attention you crave at the cost of "losing yourself." I had definitely "lost myself." Most of my thoughts were centered around what my mom needed and thought about me and my own family. I had very little boundaries when it came to dealing with my mom and I didn't know where I began or she ended. I was miserable.

Going to Celebrate Recovery changed all of that. For the first time, I felt safe to share my deepest heartaches from growing up in my family. For the first time, I learned that I could set healthy boundaries, which God has used to help strengthen my relationship with my parents and other family members. For the first time, I began learning whom God had made me to be apart from my family and the dysfunction. For the first time, in a long time, I felt free from fear and I was beginning to learn how to trust God, myself and others.

Today my relationship with my parents is better than I could have imagined. I truly enjoy being with them and I am learning how to love them for who they are with all of their weaknesses and strengths. We now declare our love for each other and we are learning to connect with each other, which I believe is one of the greatest goals God desires for all His children.

God has used Celebrate Recovery to bring healing, health and happiness to my relationships.. I'm far from perfect and still choose to attend Celebrate Recovery for continued healing in all my relationships. And I choose to continue to attend Celebrate Recovery to learn how to navigate life's constant decisions and choices through the grace and love of Jesus.

# 2019 MINISTRY ELECTIONS

The following guidelines are to be implemented as ministries conduct elections for officers designated to serve during 2019. All officer elections will be conducted during the month of November. However, in the event that an election needs to occur earlier, the Ministry Director must consult with the Senior Pastor and receive Pastoral approval.

## Ministry Officers

Each ministry of the church must have leadership positions, which will be selected through a ministry member election process, or the Pastor can directly appoint individuals.

The elected leaders will be referred to as “Officers”, and will serve in their respective leadership role for a term of one (1) year.

- a. Service in the same position is limited to no more than two consecutive one (1) year terms, for all elected officials.
- b. An officer completing two consecutive one (1) year terms in one position, is eligible to run as a candidate for another officer position
- c. Upon completion of a 2nd consecutive one (1) year term of office, there must be a one (1) year interval of separation from held elected office before being eligible for reelection to the same office.

The primary officer role may be referred to as President or Chairperson.

The following positions are also considered official officers of each ministry:

- Vice President
- Treasurer
- Corresponding Secretary
- Secretary
- Chaplain

Additional officer positions, although not elected, may be appointed by the President, but must be approved by the Ministry Director. These positions are not required to go through the election process. Examples of such positions include, but are not limited to: (Asst. Secretary, Hospitality Chair, Activities Coordinator/Team, Choir Section Leaders, etc.).

## Officer Election Process

Ministry elections – and the counting of the votes – must be conducted in the presence of the Ministry’s Deacon Liaison. If the designated Deacon Liaison is not available, at the time of the election, another Deacon Liaison may serve in his place.

Elected Officers are determined by a “majority vote” of active ministry members as defined in the policies and procedures document of the designated ministry.

Officer elections may take place by written ballot. Small ministries may also select the option of a “show of hands”. For the purpose of this process, a small ministry consists of twelve (12) members or less. Should the vote result in a tie, the voting process will be repeated until one candidate receives a majority of votes.

4. A contest cover letter due Sunday, December 2, 2018.

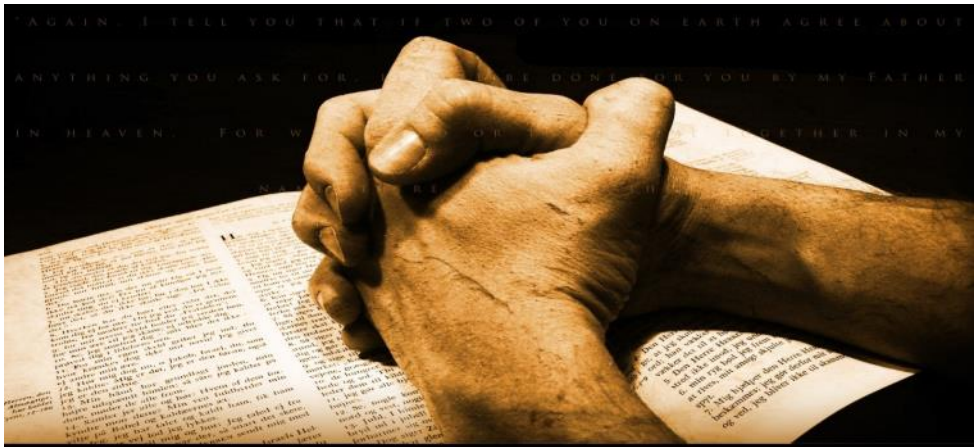
