I. WHAT'S THE BIG IDEA?

In the story of the "Sheep and the Goats," Jesus gives us a <u>picture</u> of the final <u>judgment</u>. His intention is for us to <u>live</u> this life, with the <u>end</u> in mind.

D. The <u>sheep</u> will follow their leader, <u>Jesus</u>, into God's eternal <u>Kingdom</u>.

E. The <u>goats</u> will follow their leader, the <u>Devil</u>, into eternal <u>banishment</u> from God.

F. Our eternal <u>destination</u> will be determined by our <u>choices</u> in this life.
