3. Read and discuss this quote. In William Law's book, *A Serious Call to a Holy and Devout Life*, he made this point: "the reason people don't change behavior is that they never really intend to do so. The intention to make disciples requires a plan. If you have no plan, you don't really intend to do it."
4. What do you believe is your most significant hindrance to making disciples? Has it been no clear path presented by your church? Lack of motivation? Not understanding the call to make disciples? Or something else?
5. In what way(s) have you abdicated your responsibility to be His disciple in this world?
6. When you know your "why," it will affect your "what." Why are we called to be disciples who make disciples? Matt 28:19-20
7. The 12 disciples, when called by Jesus, weren't fully complete, but they were fully committed. On a scale from 1 (not committed) to 10 (thoroughly committed), how committed are you to the call to follow Jesus?
