

Spiritual Gifts Part III - 1 Corinthians 12:10-30

1. In 1 Corinthians 12:12-30, Paul uses the illustration of a body to help the Church better understand how the gifts are to be used together. What aspects of this illustration resonate with you? What parts (if any) do you not understand?
2. In 1 Corinthians 12:14-20, Paul reiterates the fact that there are a “variety” of gifts and “service” but the same Spirit behind each one. What aspects about the variety of gifts are you learning? In what ways do you see the gifts working together for the good of the church body?
3. In 1 Corinthians 12:21-26, Paul speaks about how we should never treat someone with a different gift as lower or lesser. How can we do better in encouraging people with gifts that are different from ours?
4. What gift(s) complement your gift(s)? What gift(s) do you love seeing used most in the body? What gift(s) do you see that need to be used more in the body?
5. In 1 Corinthians 12:26, Paul says, “If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together.” What does this look like practically?
6. Of the gifts covered so far, which gift are you asking the Lord for? Pray for one another, seeking God’s will regarding your gift(s).
