- 3. What are some reasons why people are afraid of authenticity? Are any of those reasons legitimate, or at least understandable? Explain your answer.
- 4. What are some reasons that you have used to excuse yourself from Biblical community? For those reading these questions in a Home Fellowship, how has your Biblical Community helped you in your walk with Jesus? How can you encourage others to be in community as well?
- 5. Have you ever asked someone to hold you accountable? If so, how did it help you? If not, why not?
- 6. If you got sick today and were rushed to the hospital, who would know? Who would come to visit you? Who would take care of your needs for you? Who would you do these things for?
- 7. On a scale of 0 (none) to 10 (all the way), how committed are you to engage in Biblical community? Explain.?
