4. How can we prepare ourselves now to stand up under persecution when it comes to our land?

5. How can our response to changing culture, civil unrest, and political upheaval, be a calming factor in our culture or something that can turn people off to Christ? How can you help bring the peace of God to a culture that desperately needs him?
