



Galatians: Redeemed From The Curse – Galatians 3:10-14

Suggested Memory Verse: Galatians 3:13 “Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us—for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree”

1. According to Galatians 3:10, why does depending on the works of the law place a person under a curse?
2. Romans 3:20 says that through the law comes the knowledge of sin. How does God’s law help us understand our need for a Savior?
3. What are some ways Christians today can fall into a “Jesus +” mentality—trusting in Christ plus their performance, knowledge, traditions, or religious activity?
4. Galatians 3:11 says that “the righteous shall live by faith.” What does living by faith look like in your everyday relationship with God?
5. According to Isaiah 53:5–6, what did Jesus suffer on our behalf, and what does this teach us about what He accomplished for us on the cross?
6. Why is it important to remember that we obey God because we have been accepted in Christ, rather than obeying in order to earn His acceptance?
7. According to Galatians 3:14, Christ not only redeemed us from the curse but also gave us the promised Holy Spirit. How should the presence of the Holy Spirit change the way we live, obey, and represent Jesus?
