3. What are some of your fears about being different, set apart, or even weird looking to this world's system? What does "set apart" mean to you?

4. What are some excuses that you give yourself for compromising? What words or phrases do you use to justify? Ie. "Technically," "Everyone is doing it," "Just this one last time."

5. What is a disciple's motive for moral purity?

6. On a scale of 0 (not in the least) to 10 (all day, every day), how much are you committed to honoring Christ with a pure life? Explain your answer. What needs to change in your life?
