

Get Wisdom - James 1:5-11

1. Recognizing that we all need wisdom is one of the first steps to obtaining it. Where are some areas where you currently need God's wisdom to help you navigate?

2. Knowing that Jesus asked for wisdom in Matthew 26:36-42 and Paul sought wisdom in Acts 15, how does that bring you peace, knowing that some of the greatest people in the Bible also needed and asked for wisdom?

3. Why should you not ask for wisdom while refusing to obey God's direct commands? How does asking for wisdom while in direct disobedience to God and His commands make us "double-minded"?

4. Read Psalm 103:15-22. What correlation do you see between blessing the Lord and obedience?

5. Have you ever considered being poor (lowly) as something to boast about? In what ways does being in humble circumstances allow us to boast? Conversely, why is it important not to trust in our possessions and riches? (Reference Philippians 4:11-13)

6. When it comes to wisdom, God is generous and loves to give us good gifts. What are some other ways in which God is generous to His people?

7. Read 1 Kings 3:9-14. In what ways should we emulate Solomon's desire for wisdom?
