- 3. Genesis 25:23; 1 Corinthians 1:27 God chose Jacob over Esau, reversing cultural expectations. How does God's upside-down kingdom challenge the way you measure success or worth?
- 4. Genesis 25:27-28, Proverbs 22:6 Isaac and Rebekah each favored one child. How can favoritism or misplaced values impact family legacy today?
- 5. Genesis 25:29-34; Hebrews 12:16-17 Esau traded his inheritance for stew. What "bowls of stew" (temporary things) tempt you to undervalue God's promises?
- 6. Romans 12:1-2; Proverbs 3:5-6 How can renewing your mind in God's Word reshape your values so they align with His kingdom instead of the world's?
- 7. Luke 9:23; Matthew 6:33 What practical steps can you take this week to prioritize eternal rewards over instant gratification?
