- 3. Some people would say that we need "healthy" self-esteem (not prideful, not dumping on oneself). Is this biblical? Why/why not?
- 4. What is the biggest obstacle you face in seeking to be a faithful disciple of Jesus? How do you overcome it?
- 5. What is enticing to you about this earthly kingdom? What pulls you away from the Kingdom of God toward the kingdom of this world?
- 6. Take some time to pray for one another regarding the things that pull us away from God's Kingdom.
