Evangelistically Bold - Mark 16:15

4. How do you conduct yourself on social media? Do people message you privately and ask for prayer, or do people rebuke you for being harsh and unloving? How should a disciple of Jesus communicate on these platforms?
5. What are some common excuses that people give for not sharing the Gospel?
6. How does our love for people help us share the Gospel? How does our influence/seasoning help us share the Gospel? How does our service to others allow us to share the Gospel more effectively?
7. On a scale from 0 (zip) to 10 (totally), how evangelistically bold are you? Explain your answer. What needs to get better?
