Sermon title: What's it Going to Take?

Theme: Changing the state of homelessness in San Diego

Scripture: John 6:1-15

Principles:

It's going to take Compassion - v. 5

It's going to take Personal Involvement - v. 6

Its going to take a Miracle - v. 7

Reflection questions:

1. What is the people group for whom you have the most compassion? Why?

2. In Matthew's account of the feeding of the 5,000, (Matthew 14:13-14) it reads, "When Jesus heard what had happened*, he withdrew by boat privately to a solitary place. Hearing of this, the crowds followed him on foot from the towns. When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them and healed their sick."

*John the Baptist had just been beheaded

Imagine you were Jesus and you were retreating from your pain to a private, solitary place and crowds started following you from all the surrounding towns. You look and see the large crowds coming toward you. How would you feel?

- 3. Why do you think people follow Jesus today? Why don't they?
- 4. Describe a time in your life when you had a hard time trusting God, but he came through and provided for your needs.
- 5. What do you believe the church's role should be when it comes to serving our most vulnerable neighbors and loving on our local community (homeless, refugees, immigrants, sex-trafficked, foster children, veterans, etc.)? What gets in the way?
- 6. What misperception do you currently have about those experiencing homelessness and what is one thing you can do this week to lean in and move toward them with Christ-like compassion?
