Luke 21:34 NIV Be careful, or your hearts will be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness and the anxieties of life, and that day will close on you suddenly like a trap.

More Or Less

Luke 15:11-12 NIV ¹¹ Jesus continued: "There was a man who had two sons. ¹² The younger one said to his father, 'Father, give me my share of the estate.' So he divided his property between them.

1. We're more stressed when we're <u>consumed</u> with more.

Luke 15:13 NIV ¹³ "Not long after that, the younger son got together all he had, set off for a distant country...

2. We're more stressed when want **everything now**.

Luke 15:13 NIV ... and there squandered his wealth in wild living.

3. We're more stressed when we engage in <u>self-destructive behavior</u>.

Luke 15:14 NIV After he had spent everything...

4. We're more stressed when we **spend** everything we have.

Luke 15:14 NIV ...there was a severe famine in that whole country, and he began to be in need.

5. We're more stressed when we're <u>unprepared</u> for storms.

Luke 15:17 NIV "When he came to his senses, he said, 'How many of my father's hired servants have food to spare, and here I am starving to death!

Isaiah 9:6 NIV For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Sar: Lord, chief, general, the one in charge.

Shalom: Rest, tranquility, wholeness, completeness, contentment.

Principles of Peace

1. Obedience

Malachi 3:7-12 NIV ⁷ Ever since the time of your ancestors you have turned away from my decrees and have not kept them. Return to me, and I will return to you," says the Lord Almighty. "But you ask, 'How are we to return?' ⁸ "Will a mere mortal rob God? Yet you rob me. "But you ask, 'How are we robbing you?' "In tithes and offerings. ⁹ You are under a curse—your whole nation—because you are robbing me. ¹⁰ Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the Lord Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it. ¹¹ I will prevent pests from devouring your crops, and the vines in your fields will not drop their fruit before it is ripe," says the Lord Almighty. ¹² "Then all the nations will call you blessed, for yours will be a delightful land," says the Lord Almighty.

2. Contentment

1 Timothy 6:6-10 NIV ⁶ But godliness with contentment is great gain. ⁷ For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it. ⁸ But if we have food and clothing, we will be content with that. ⁹ Those who want to get rich fall into temptation and a trap and into many foolish and harmful desires that plunge people into ruin and destruction. ¹⁰ For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

Proverbs 30:8-9 NIV Keep falsehood and lies far from me; give me neither poverty nor riches, but give me only my daily bread.

9 Otherwise, I may have too much and disown you and say, 'Who is the Lord?' Or I may become poor and steal, and so dishonor the name of my God.

3. Margin

Proverbs 21:20 NIV The wise store up choice food and olive oil, but fools gulp theirs down.

4. Generosity

Psalm 112:5 NIV Good will come to those who are generous and lend freely, who conduct their affairs with justice.

Proverbs 11:25 NIV A generous person will prosper; whoever refreshes others will be refreshed.

5. Integrity

Proverbs 20:23 NIV The Lord detests differing weights, and dishonest scales do not please him.

6. Dependence

John 16:24 NIV Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.

Luke 15:18-20 NIV ¹⁸I will set out and go back to my father and say to him: Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. ¹⁹I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me like one of your hired servants.' ²⁰So he got up and went to his father. "But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, threw his arms around him and kissed him.
