2 KINGS 7:1 (NKJV)

SO AN OFFICER ON WHOSE HAND THE KING LEANED ANSWERED THE MAN OF GOD AND SAID, “LOOK, */F* THE LORD WOULD MAKE WINDOWS IN HEAVEN, COULD THIS THING BE?” AND HE SAID, “IN FACT, YOU SHALL SEE */F* WITH YOUR EYES, BUT YOU SHALL NOT EAT OF IT.”

2 KINGS 7:17-20 (NKJV)

NOW THE KING HAD APPOINTED THE OFFICER ON WHOSE HAND HE LEANED TO HAVE CHARGE OF THE GATE. BUT THE PEOPLE TRAMPLED HIM IN THE GATE, AND HE DIED, JUST AS THE MAN OF GOD HAD SAID, WHO SPOKE WHEN THE KING CAME DOWN TO HIM. <sup>18</sup>SO IT HAPPENED JUST AS THE MAN OF GOD HAD SPOKEN TO THE KING, SAYING, “TWO SEAHS OF BARLEY FOR A SHEKEL, AND A SEAH OF FINE FLOUR FOR A SHEKEL, **SHALL BE *SOLD*** TOMORROW ABOUT THIS TIME IN THE GATE OF SAMARIA.” <sup>19</sup>THEN THAT OFFICER HAD ANSWERED THE MAN OF GOD, AND SAID, “NOW LOOK, *IF* THE LORD WOULD MAKE WINDOWS IN HEAVEN, COULD SUCH A THING BE?” AND HE HAD SAID, “IN FACT, YOU SHALL SEE *IT* WITH YOUR EYES, BUT YOU SHALL NOT EAT OF IT.” <sup>20</sup>AND SO IT HAPPENED TO HIM, FOR THE PEOPLE TRAMPLED HIM IN THE GATE, AND HE DIED.



2 KINGS 7:3-7 (NKJV)

NOW THERE WERE FOUR LEPROUS MEN AT THE ENTRANCE OF THE GATE; AND THEY SAID TO ONE ANOTHER, “WHY ARE WE SITTING HERE UNTIL WE DIE? <sup>4</sup>IF WE SAY, ‘WE WILL ENTER THE CITY,’ THE FAMINE *IS* IN THE CITY, AND WE SHALL DIE THERE. AND IF WE SIT HERE, WE DIE ALSO. NOW THEREFORE, COME, LET US SURRENDER TO THE ARMY OF THE SYRIANS. IF THEY KEEP US ALIVE, WE SHALL LIVE; AND IF THEY KILL US, WE SHALL ONLY DIE.” <sup>5</sup>AND THEY ROSE AT TWILIGHT TO GO TO THE CAMP OF THE SYRIANS; AND WHEN THEY HAD COME TO THE OUTSKIRTS OF THE SYRIAN CAMP, TO THEIR SURPRISE NO ONE *WAS* THERE. <sup>6</sup>FOR THE LORD HAD CAUSED THE ARMY OF THE SYRIANS TO HEAR THE NOISE OF CHARIOTS AND THE NOISE OF HORSES—THE NOISE OF A GREAT ARMY; SO THEY SAID TO ONE ANOTHER, “LOOK, THE KING OF ISRAEL HAS HIRED AGAINST US THE KINGS OF THE HITTITES AND THE KINGS OF THE EGYPTIANS TO ATTACK US!” <sup>7</sup>THEREFORE THEY AROSE AND FLED AT TWILIGHT, AND LEFT THE CAMP INTACT—THEIR TENTS, THEIR HORSES, AND THEIR DONKEYS—AND THEY FLED FOR THEIR LIVES.
