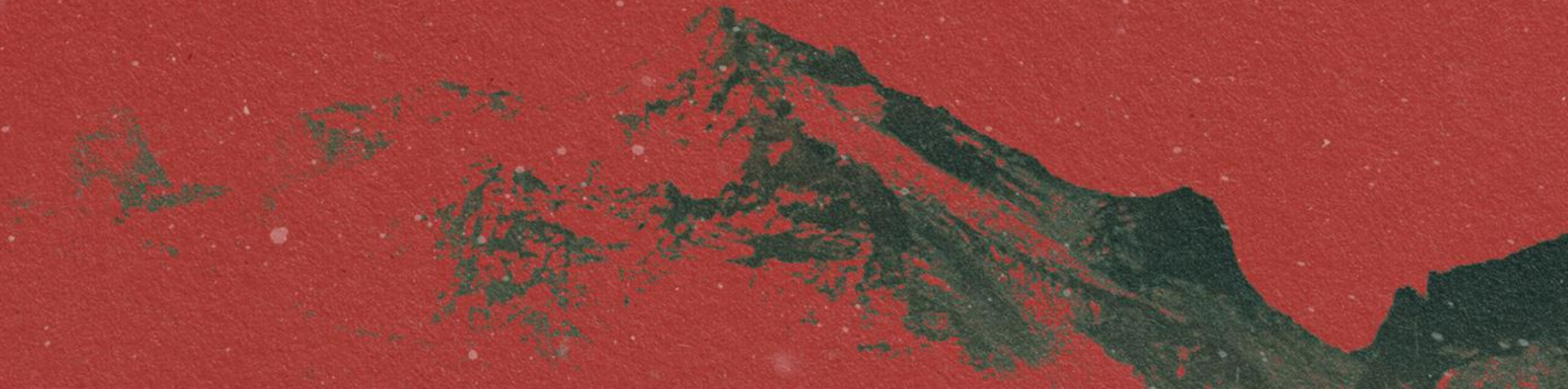

Let the word of Christ **DWELL IN YOU.**

Greek Word for DWELL:

Noun – House or Dwelling.

Verb – Dwelling in or living
within something

We use legalism to excuse our LAZINESS.

Matthew 13:2-4_{NKJV}

And great multitudes were gathered together to Him, so that He got into a boat and sat; and the whole multitude stood on the shore. Then He spoke many things to them in parables, saying: “Behold, a sower went out to sow. ⁴ And as he sowed, some *seed* fell by the wayside; and the birds came and devoured them.

Matthew 13:5-8^{NKJV}

Some fell on stony places, where they did not have much earth; and they immediately sprang up because they had no depth of earth. ⁶ But when the sun was up they were scorched, and because they had no root they withered away. ⁷ And some fell among thorns, and the thorns sprang up and choked them. ⁸ But others fell on good ground and yielded a crop: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. ⁹ He who has ears to hear, let him hear!”

Luke 12:24-27_{NKJV}

Consider the ravens, for they neither sow nor reap, which have neither storehouse nor barn; and God feeds them. **OF HOW MUCH MORE VALUE ARE YOU THAN THE BIRDS?** ²⁵ And which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature? ²⁶ If you then are not able to do *the* least, why are you anxious for the rest? ²⁷ Consider the lilies, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; and yet I say to you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.
