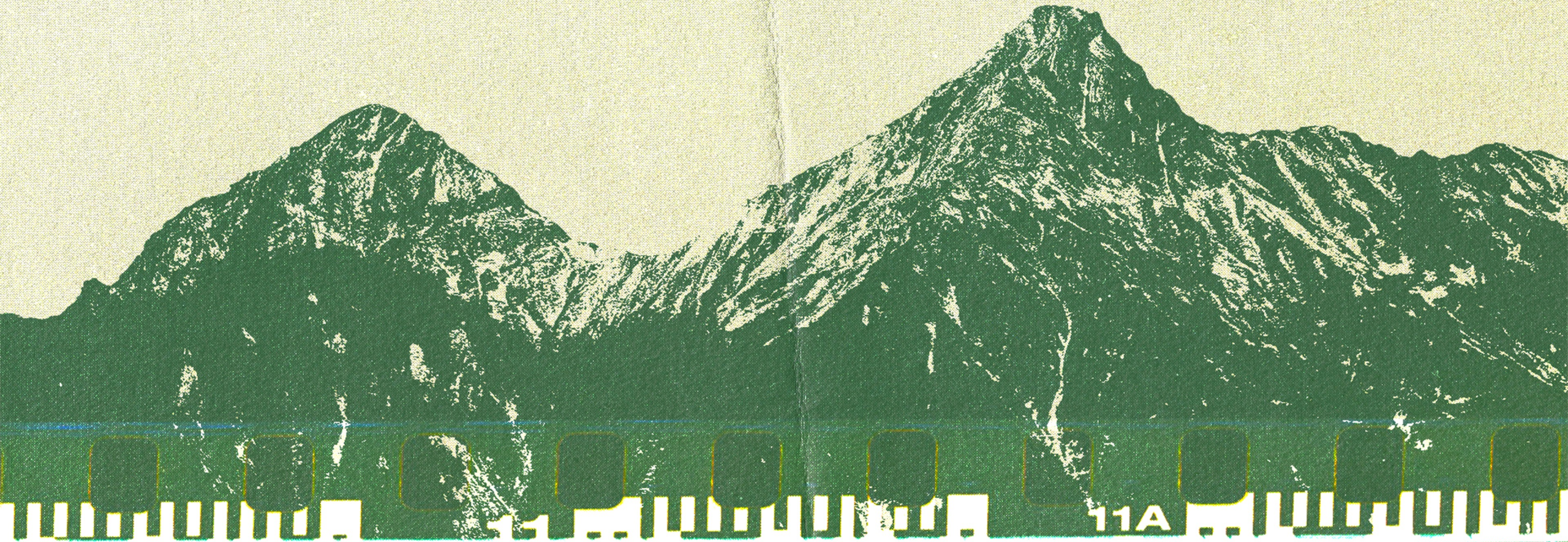


Preparation

FOR THE PROMISED LAND



1 Samuel 10:1-2^(NKJV)

Then Samuel took a flask of oil and poured *it* on his head, and kissed him and said: “*Is it not because the LORD has anointed you commander over His inheritance?*”² When you have departed from me today, you will find two men by Rachel’s tomb in the territory of Benjamin at Zelzah; and they will say to you, “The donkeys which you went to look for have been found. And now your father has ceased caring about the donkeys and is worrying about you, saying, “What shall I do about my son?””

⁵ After that you shall come to the hill of God where the Philistine garrison is. And it will happen, when you have come there to the city, that you will meet a group of prophets coming down from the high place with a stringed instrument, a tambourine, a flute, and a harp before them; and they will be prophesying. ⁶ Then the Spirit of the LORD will come upon you, and you will prophesy with them and be turned into another man. ⁷ And let it be, when these signs come to you, *that* you do as the occasion demands; for God *is* with you.

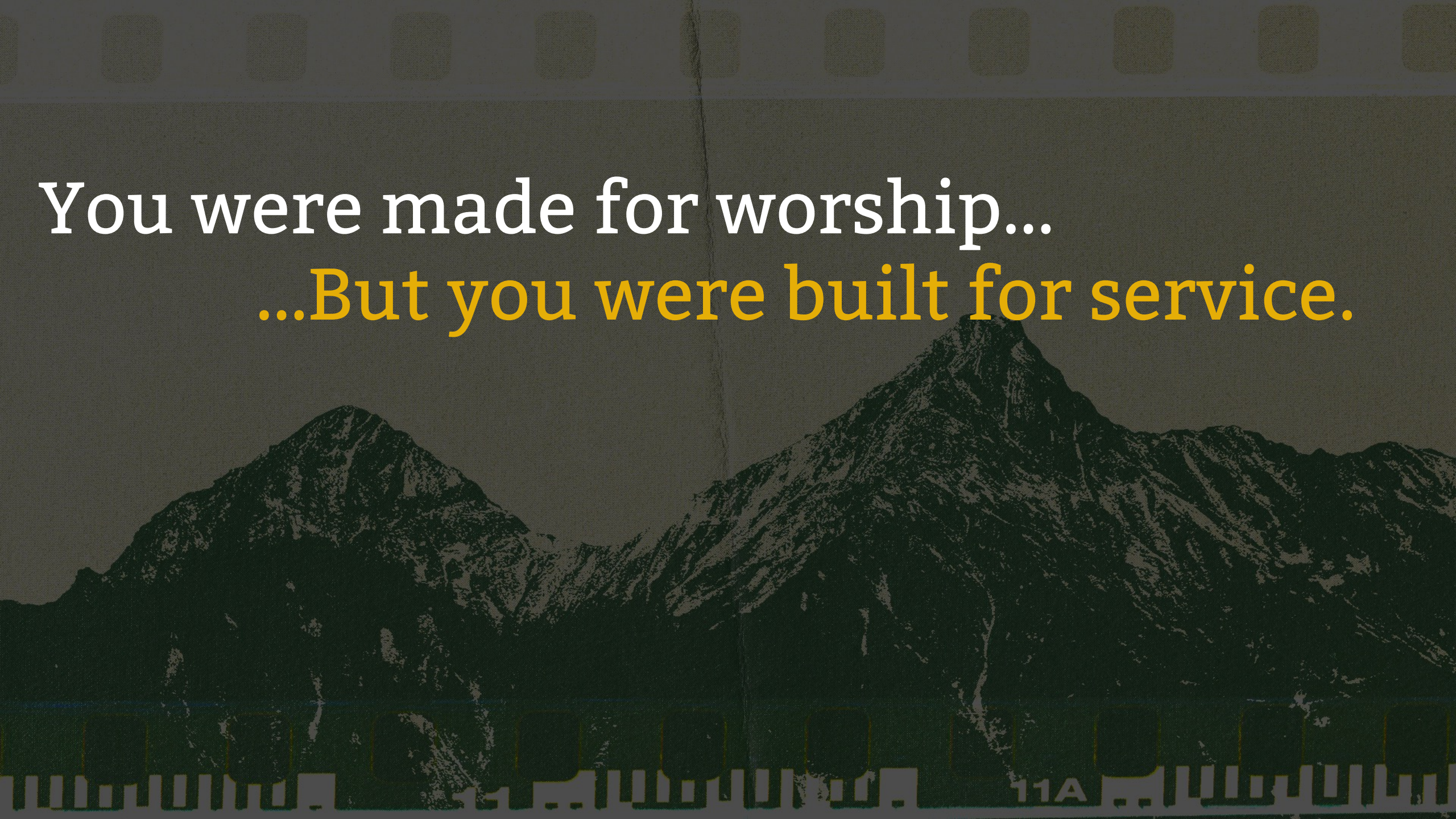

“Do I do what God wants me to do?”

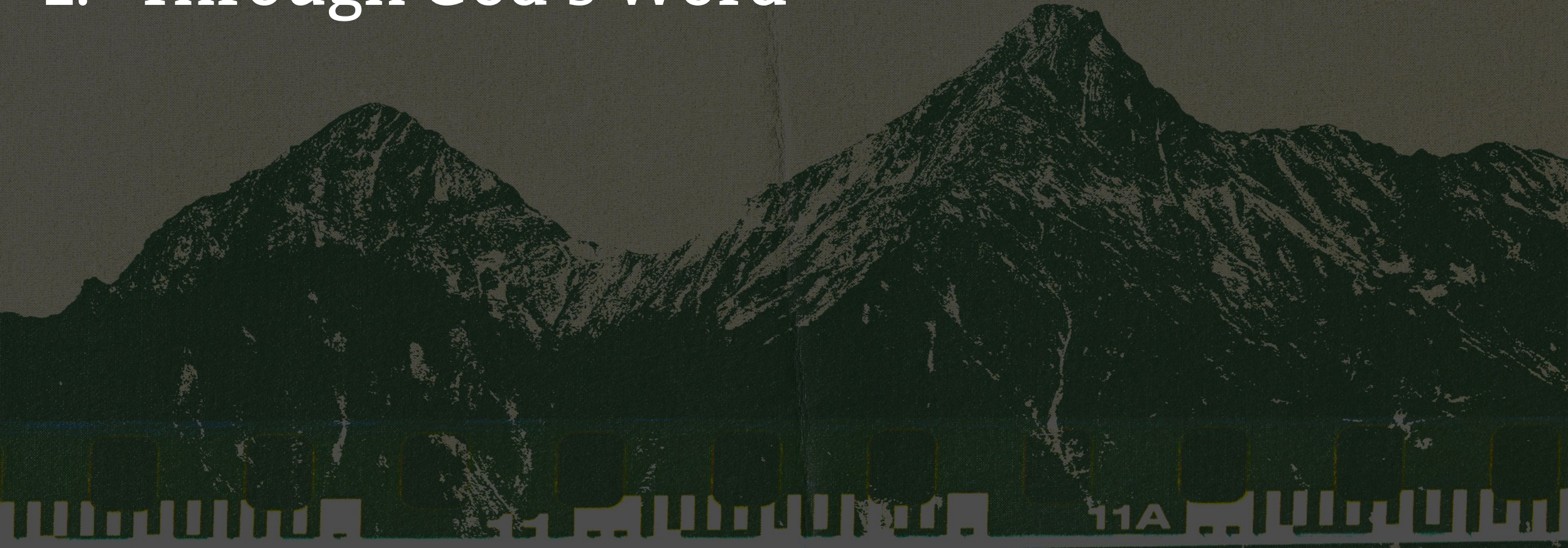
