

Luke 23:13-17(NKJV)

Then Pilate, when he had called together the chief priests, the rulers, and the people, 14 said to them, "You have brought this Man to me, as one who misleads the people. And indeed, having examined *Him* in your presence, I have found no fault in this Man concerning those things of which you accuse Him; 15 no, neither did Herod, for I sent you back to him; and indeed nothing deserving of death has been done by Him. 16 I will therefore chastise Him and release Him" 17 (for it was necessary for him to release one to them at the feast).

Luke 23:18-21(NKJV)

And they all cried out at once, saying, "Away with this *Man*, and release to us Barabbas"— ¹⁹ who had been thrown into prison for a certain rebellion made in the city, and for murder. ²⁰ Pilate, therefore, wishing to release Jesus, again called out to them. ²¹ But they shouted, saying, "Crucify *Him*, crucify Him!"

Luke 23:22-25(NKJV)

Then he said to them the third time, "Why, what evil has He done? I have found no reason for death in Him. I will therefore chastise Him and let Him go."

²³ But they were insistent, demanding with loud voices that He be crucified. And the voices of these men and of the chief priests prevailed. ²⁴ So Pilate gave sentence that it should be as they requested. ²⁵ And he released to them the one they requested, who for rebellion and murder had been thrown into prison; but he delivered Jesus to their will.

Luke 23:39-43(NKJV)

Then one of the criminals who were hanged blasphemed Him, saying, "If You are the Christ, save Yourself and us." 40 But the other, answering, rebuked him, saying, "Do you not even fear God, seeing you are under the same condemnation? 41 And we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong." 42 Then he said to Jesus, "Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom." 43 And Jesus said to him, "Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise."

1 Timothy 2:5-6(NKJV) For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, ⁶ who gave Himself a ransom for all...

Matthew 27:16-17(NIV)

At that time they had a well-known prisoner whose name was <u>Jesus</u> <u>Barabbas</u>. ¹⁷ So when the crowd had gathered, Pilate asked them, "Which one do you want me to release to you: <u>Jesus Barabbas</u>, or Jesus who is called the Messiah?"

Jesus = Deliverer

Barabbas = Son of a father

Jesus Barabbas =

Deliverance through the strength of the sons of men.

<u>Jesus Christ</u> = Delivered because of the Anointed One

Proverbs 13:15(NKJV) ...the way of transgressors is hard.

Isaiah 53:12(NKJV) And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors.

Jesus had to be treated like Barabbas... So Barabbas could be treated like Jesus.

Job 9:33(NIV) If only there were someone to mediate between us, someone to bring us together...

Romans 8:34(NKJV)

It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.

Hebrews 7:25(NKJV)

He always lives to make intercession for them.
