



THE HOLY SPIRIT

1 Corinthians 12:4-11

There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. ⁵ There are differences of ministries, but the same Lord. ⁶ And there are diversities of activities, but it is the same God who works all in all. ⁷ But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit *of all*: ⁸ for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, ⁹ to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, ¹⁰ to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another *different* kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. ¹¹ But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

2. THE GIFTS OF HEALINGS
3. THE WORKINGS OF MIRACLES

Group 3 Vocal/Inspirational Gifts

Supernaturally *Say* Something

1. THE GIFT OF PROPHECY
2. THE GIFT OF TONGUES
3. THE INTERPRETATION OF TONGUES

Greek Words for “Healing”

IAMA = Physical Cures — word used for medical recoveries

SOZO & DIASOZO = to make whole, to make well



Mark 6:56 “As many as touched him were made well.”

Mark 16:18

They will lay hands on the sick, and they will
recover.

Greek Words for “Healing”

IAMA = Physical Cures — word used for medical recoveries

SOZO & DIASOZO = to make whole, to make well

KALOS ECHO = get well; a process of recuperation

Luke 17:11-19

Now it happened as He went to Jerusalem that He passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. ¹² Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off. ¹³ And they lifted up *their* voices and said, “Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!”

¹⁴ So when He saw *them*, He said to them, “Go, show yourselves to the priests.” And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed.

¹⁵ And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, ¹⁶ and fell down on *his* face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan.

¹⁷ So Jesus answered and said, “Were there not ten cleansed? But where *are* the nine? ¹⁸ Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?” ¹⁹ And He said to him, “Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you whole.”

10 Lepers Healing – 4 different words used

1. Mercy
2. Cleansing
3. Whole
4. Healing

Some healings happen through process.

Like salvation, healing is to the “whosoever.”

Our faith should rest on God, not healing.

Matthew 4:23

And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.

Acts 5:12

And through the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders were done among the people.

Acts 5:16

Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and they were all healed.

Acts 28:9

...the rest of those on the island who had diseases also came and were healed.

is not found in the Bible.
