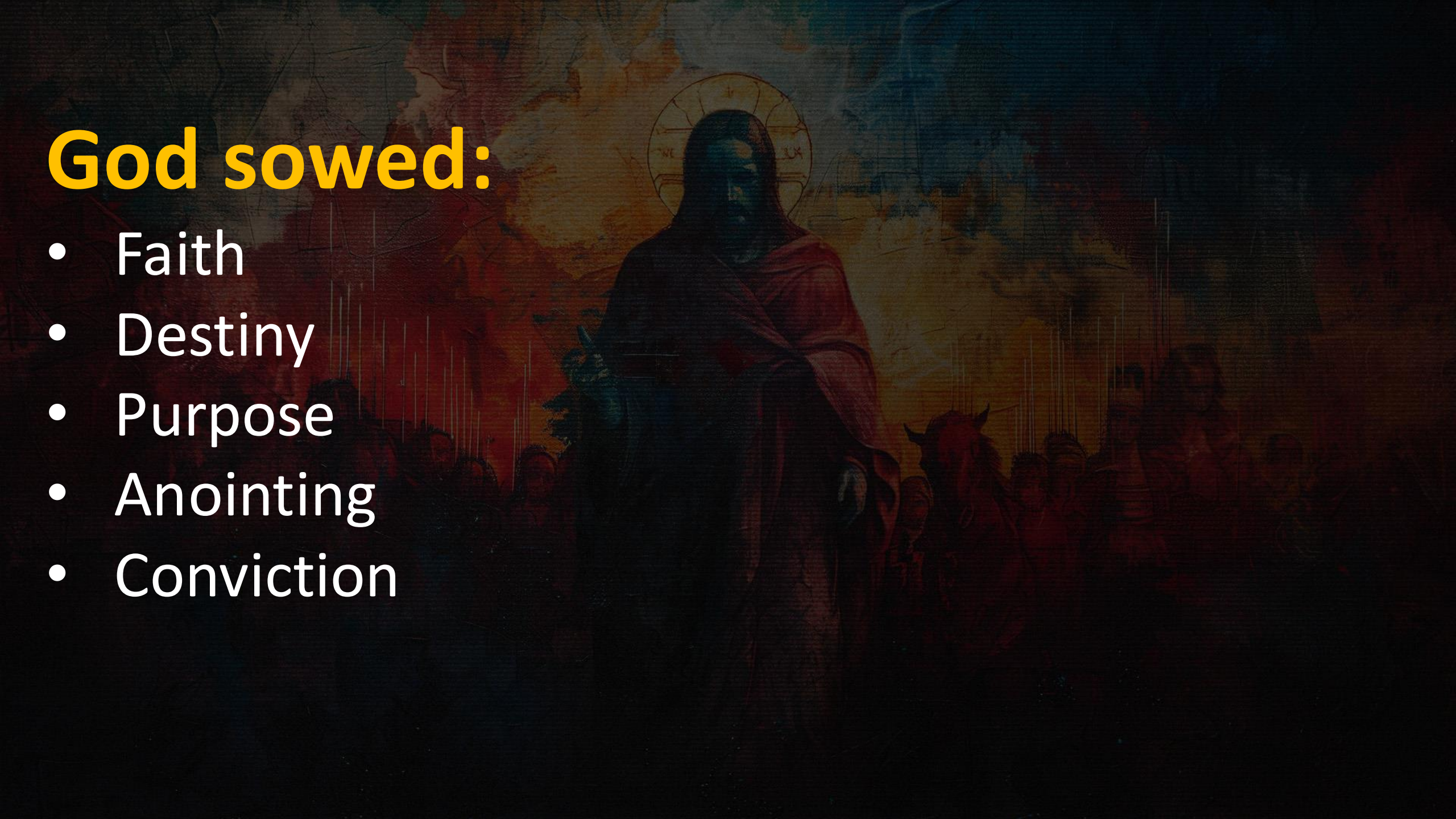


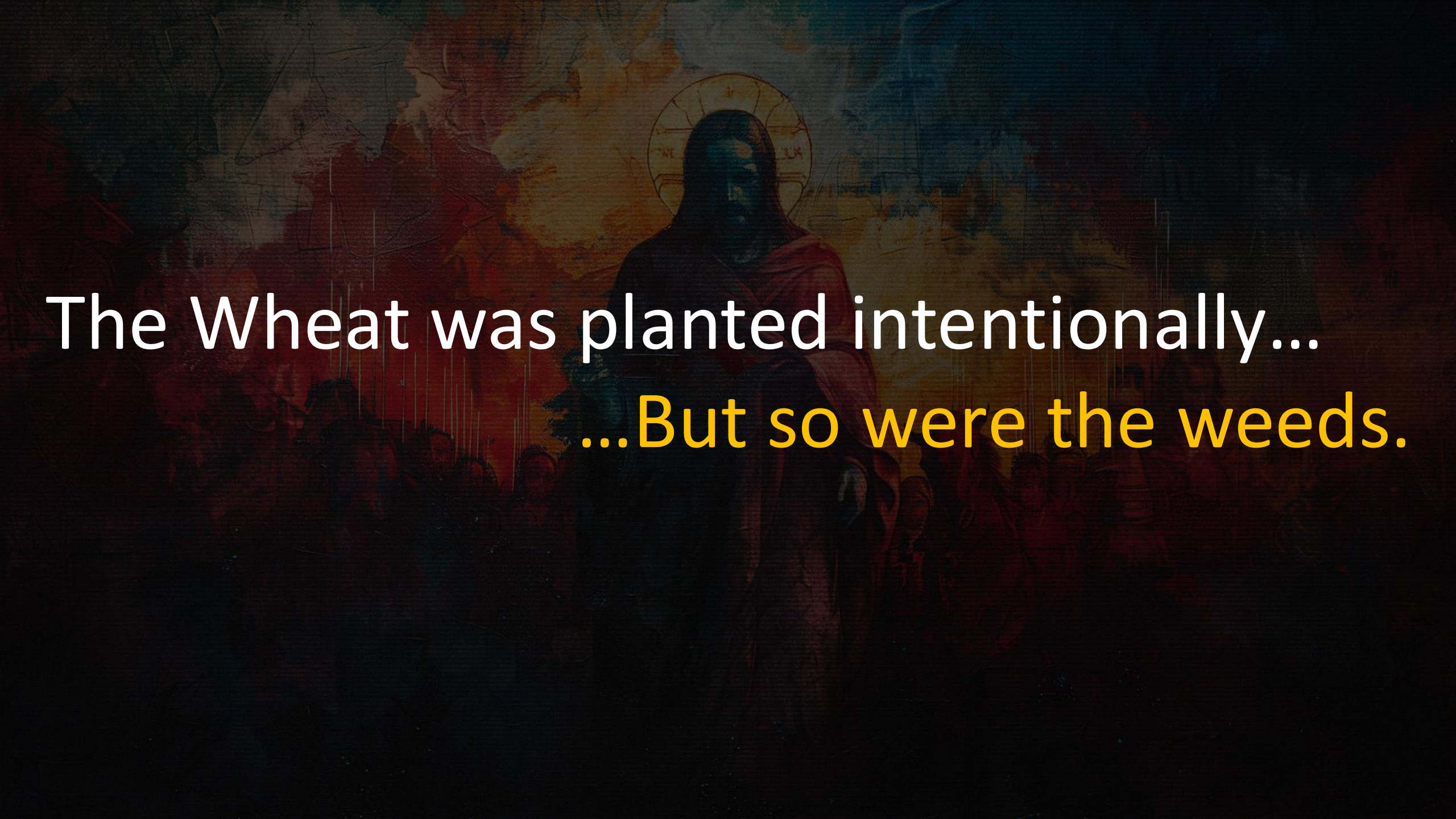
Matthew 13:28-30_{NKJV}

...But so were the weeds.

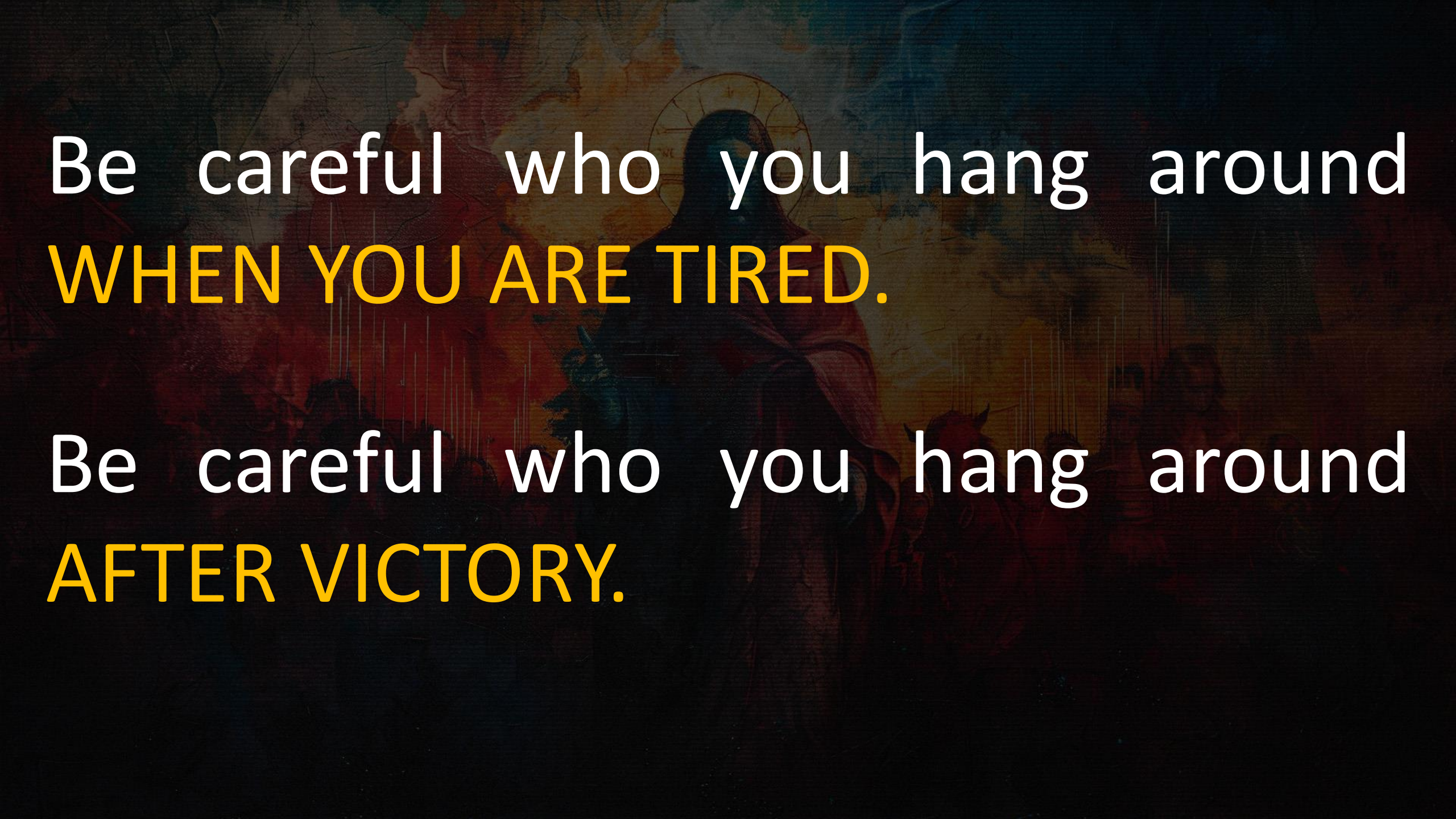

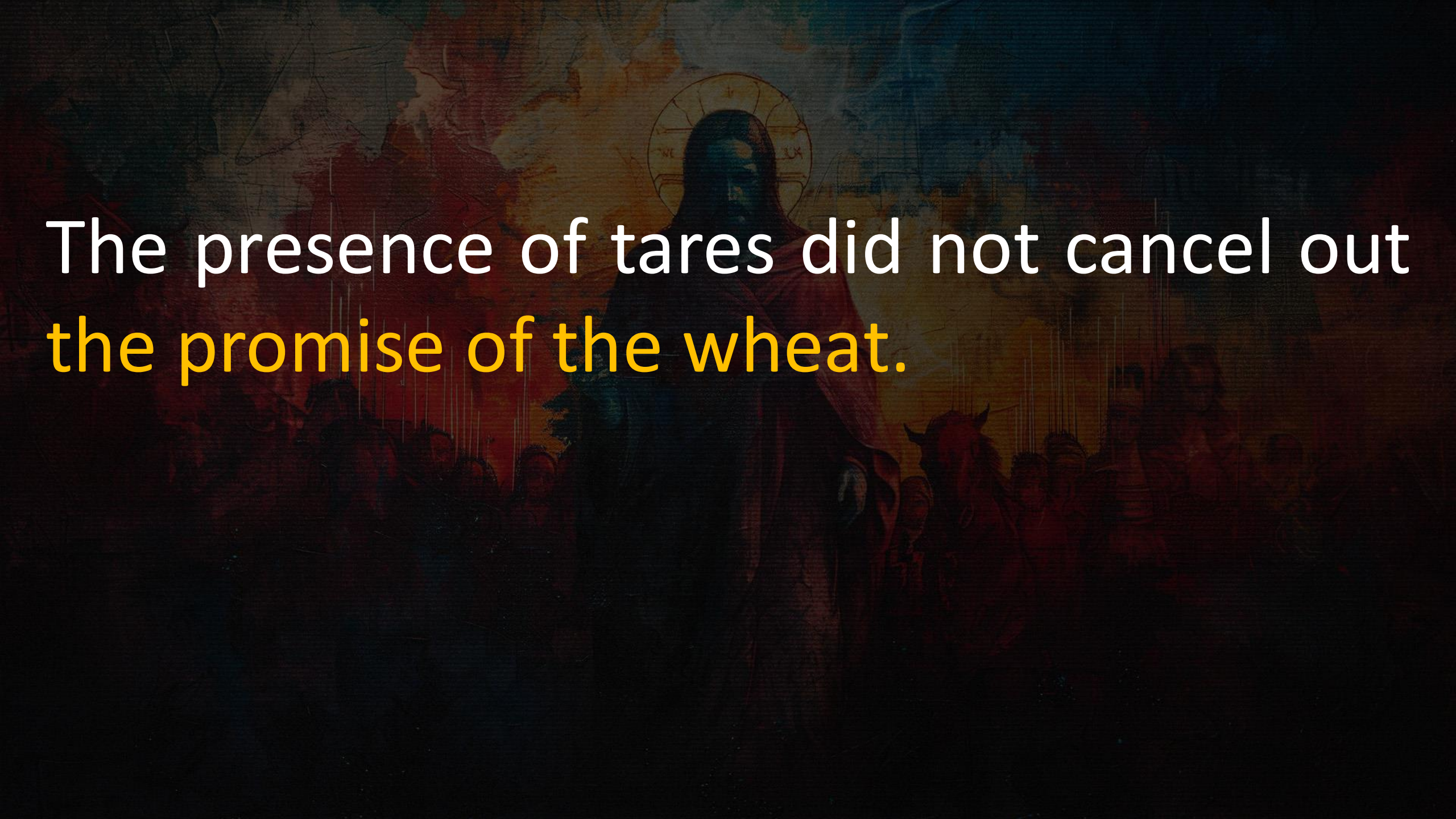
