THE COMING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT



Acts 2:1-4 (NKJV)

When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. ² And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³ Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and *one* sat upon each of them. ⁴ And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Pentecost

Acts 2:14-15 (NKJV)

But Peter, standing up with the eleven, raised his voice and said to them, “Men of Judea and all who dwell in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and heed my words.
¹⁵ For these are not drunk, as you suppose, since it is *only* the third hour of the day.

Pentecost

Acts 2:38-39 (NKJV)

Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. ³⁹ For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.”

Pentecost

Acts 2:40 (NKJV)

And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, “Be saved from this perverse generation.”

Pentecost

Acts 2:41 (NKJV)

Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added *to them*.

Pentecost

Acts 2:46-47 (NKJV)

So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, ⁴⁷ praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

Pentecost

Psalm 122:1 (NKJV)

I was glad when they said to me, “Let us go into the house of the LORD.”

Pentecost

Psalm 84:10 (NKJV)

I would rather be a doorkeeper in the
house of my God Than dwell in the tents of
wickedness.

Pentecost

1/3 fewer Americans attend church
now than in 1993.

Pentecost

Only 36% of Christians attend church
once a week.

Pentecost

Matthew 16:18 (NKJV)

And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

Pentecost

Acts 1:3 (NKJV)

He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God.

Pentecost

Acts 1:8 (NKJV)

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

Pentecost

Acts 1:9-11 (NKJV)

Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. ¹⁰And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel, ¹¹ who also said, “Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This *same* Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven.”

Pentecost

Pentecost: A Greek word meaning 50.

Celebrated in Old Testament as “Shavout”
or “Feast of Weeks.”

50 Days after Passover

Pentecost

Pentecost is determined by Passover.

You can have Passover w/out Pentecost...

You CANNOT have Pentecost w/out Passover!

If there's been no death,
there can be no Pentecost.

John 16:7 (NKJV)

Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you.
