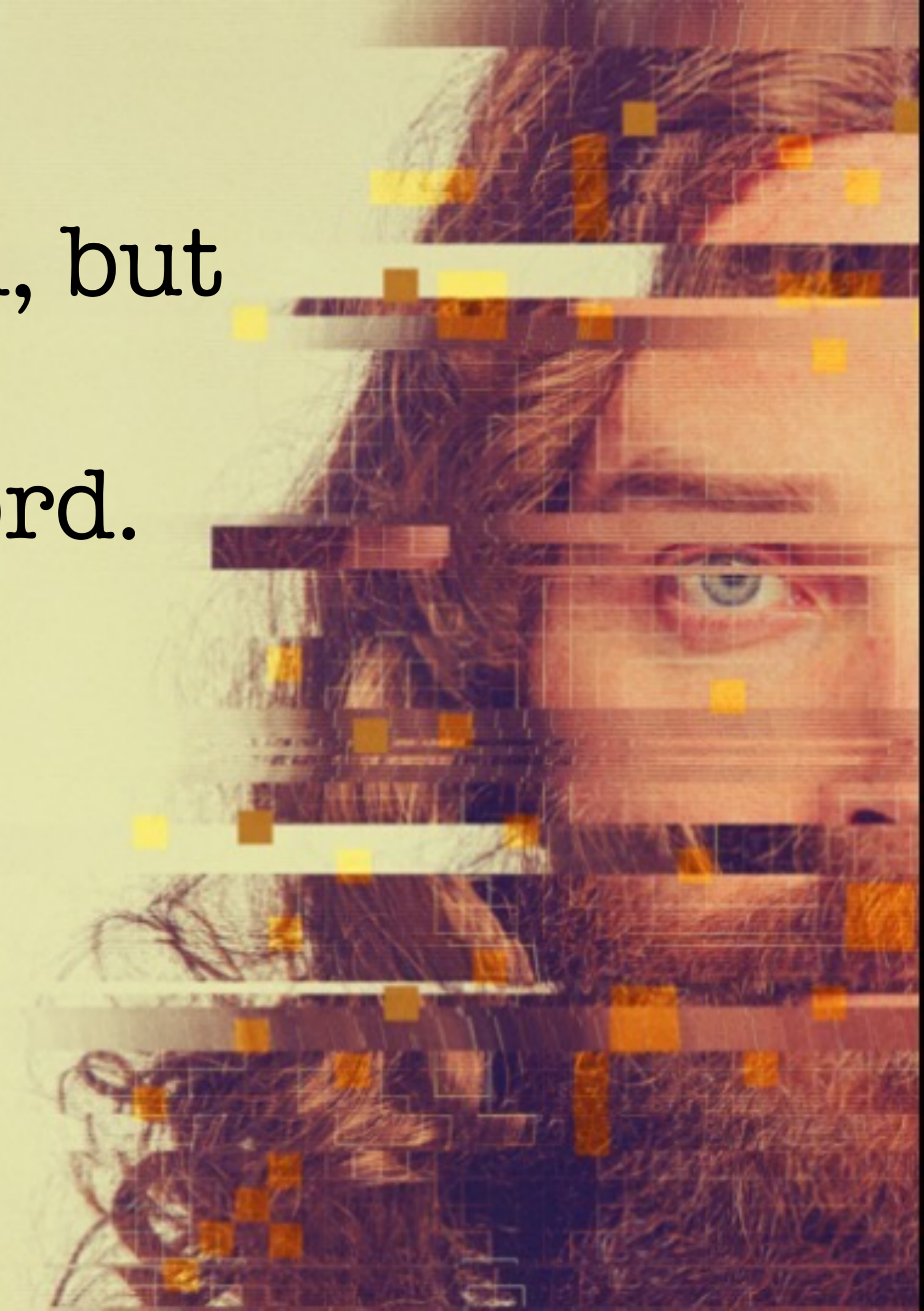
MATTHEW 16:15
